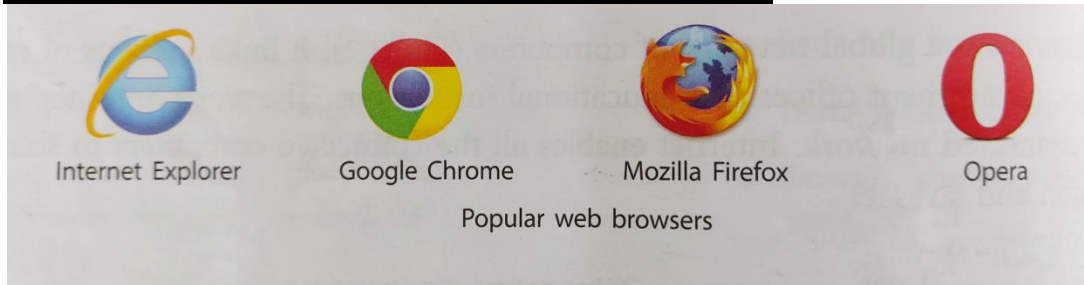

- a) The Internet is a global network of computers. It links millions of people, businesses, government offices and educational institutions. The word 'Internet' stands for Interconnected network. It enables all the connected computers to share information and services.
- b) A computer system with an Internet Service Provider (ISP), a modem, a phone line and a web browser are the basic requirements to use the Internet.
- c) The steps to add a favourite web page are as follows:
 - i. Click on the Favorites button.
 - ii. Click on Add to favorites. The Add a Favorite dialog box appears.
 - iii. Type the name and the folder details in the Name box and Create in box.
 - iv. Click on Add.

- d) The uses of the Navigation buttons are as follows:
 - i. Refresh button – This button is used to reload the current web page.
 - ii. Backward and Forward buttons – These buttons let you browse the recently viewed web pages.
 - iii. Home – This button opens the first page of the web browser at any point of time.
 - iv. Close button – This button is used to close the Internet Explorer.
