Nouns are words that name people, places, animals and things. They are also called naming words.

Examples: Kolkata, chair, dog, Alisha etc.

b. Proper Noun are special names of people, places, animals or things. Proper nouns always begins with capital letters.

Examples: Rahul, Victoria Memorial, Linc pen etc.
