

A food web shows how energy is passed on from one living thing to the next. It shows the feeding habits of different animals that live together in an ecosystem. In the food web pictured on the left, energy is passed from the grass to the mouse to the snake to the hawk. Producers are living things that make their own food with sun and air. The producers are pictured at the bottom of the food web. Consumers are living things that eat other living things.
